Deciduous Shrubs

Acer | Maple

Acer ginnala 'Bailey Compact' | Bailey Compact Amur Maple Zone 3-7 H 7-8' x W 7-8'
Finely branched, compact, rounded form of the Amur Maple; for borders, hedges, or foundation plantings. Excellent scarlet-red fall color.

Acer ginnala 'Flame' | Flame Amur Maple Zone 3-7 H 15-20' x W 20-25'
Graceful large shrub or small tree for any landscape. Plant in masses for attractive screen or use as specimen tree in small spaces. Beautiful red fall color and attractive clusters of seeds persist to add winter interest as well. Tolerates a wide range of conditions. May be sheared into a large hedge or screen.

Amelanchier | Serviceberry, Juneberry

Amelanchier alnifolia 'Regent' | Regent Serviceberry Zone 2-7 H 4-8' x W 4-8'
Mounded, shrub form of our native Juneberry. Suitable for foundation or border planting. Fluffy white flower clusters in early spring produce delicious, sweet, dark fruits-very attractive to birds as well. Excellent yellow, orange to red fall color even in shade. Very adaptable.

Amelanchier alnifolia 'Saskatoon' | Saskatoon Serviceberry Zone 3 H 8-10' W 8-10'
Full sun to part shade. Excellent white flowers 1/3"-1/2" bluish-black berries ripen in June/July. Yellow/orange fall color. Thicket forming. Bird magnet.

Amorpha canescens | Leadplant Zone 3 H 2-3' W 2'-3'.
A good shrub for erosion control that also helps fix nitrogen in the soil. Small oval gray-green leaves. Purple blooms.

Amorpha fruticosa | False Indigo Zone 3 H 8'-10' W 10-12'.
Long spikes of purple flowers in early summer. Drought resistant and good for poor soils. Will fix nitrogen in the soil. Full Sun.

Aronia | Chokeberry

Aronia melanocarpa elata | Glossy Black Chokeberry Zone 3-7 H 4-6' x W 4-6'
Excellent landscape shrub. Compact, rounded form with white flowers in May. Persistent black fruit and brilliant fall color. Super hardy and adaptable.

Aronia melanocarpa 'Autumn Magic' | *Autumn Magic Black Chokeberry* Zone 3-7 H 3-5' x W 3-5'
Cultivar from British Columbia. Similar to the species, but with very persistent fruits and superior red to purple fall color.

Atriplex | Saltbush

Atriplex canescens | *Four Wing Saltbush* Zone 4 H 4-6' x W 4-6'
A native shrub with dark gray-green foliage. Tiny light yellow flowers borne on tips of branches. Produces clusters of four-winged, light green seeds maturing to rose color in the fall.

Berberis | Barberry

Berberis koreana x thunbergii 'Golden Carousel'® | *Golden Carousel Barberry* Zone 4 H 4-5' x W 3-4'
Glowing golden-yellow foliage tipped with orange and reds. Does best in light shade where leaves are protected from fading or burning in late summer.

Berberis thunbergii 'Bagatelle' | *Bagatelle Barberry* Zone 4-7 H 15" x W 15"
Dwarf, slow growing plant that looks like a miniature Crimson Pygmy Barberry, which makes it well suited for rock gardens and very small hedges.

Berberis thunbergii 'Concorde' | *Concorde Japanese Barberry* Zone 4-8 H 2' x W 3'
Dwarf, globe-shaped with deep purple, velvety foliage accented by new growth in red. Fruit is red and sparse. Tolerates dry conditions well.

Berberis thunbergii 'Helmond Pillar' | *Helmond Pillar Barberry* Zone 4-8 H 4-5' x W 2'
Deep purple colored foliage and narrow columnar growth habit make this a great selection for structure and color in the garden.

Berberis thunbergii atropurpurea 'Ruby Carousel'® | *Ruby Carousel Barberry* Zone 4-7 H 3-3.5' x W 3.5'
Japanese red barberry selected for uniform shape and red color. Nice red-purple fall color. May be used as a specimen or hedge.

Berberis thunbergii atropurpurea 'Crimson Pygmy' | *Crimson Pygmy Barberry* Zone 4-7 H 2' x W 2-3'
Compact mounded plant with burgundy red foliage. Well suited for planting in a low hedge.

Berberis thunbergii atropurpurea 'Rosy Glow' | *Rosy Glow Barberry* Zone 4-7 H 3' x W 2-3'
Attractive burgundy foliage with pink and rose variegation and good fall color.

Berberis x 'Emerald Carousel'® | *Rosy Glow Barberry Emerald Carousel Barberry* Zone 4-7 H 4-5' x W 4-5'
Rounded plant with arching branches develops outstanding fall color early. Can be used as a specimen, hedge, or thorny barrier.

Buddleia | Butterfly Bush

Buddleia alternifolia | *Fountain Butterfly Bush* Zone 4 H 8-10' x W 6-8'

Perhaps the only reliably hardy butterfly bush for our area. Can be a small tree or large shrub. Graceful, wide spreading habit with dull, dark green foliage and white undersides. Fragrant flowers in June. Blooms on old wood.

Buddleia davidii 'Black Knight' | *Black Knight Butterfly Bush* Zone 6 H 8-10' x W 6-8'

Dark purple, showy flowers on long slender branches. Vase shape form. Not very reliable in Cheyenne, but may survive in protected areas.

Buddleia davidii 'Pink Delight' | *Pink Delight Butterfly Bush* Zone 6 H 4-5' x W 3-5'

Lavender-pink flowers on long slender spikes. Not very reliable in Cheyenne, but may survive in protected areas.

Buxus | Boxwood

Buxus 'Glencoe' | *Chicagoland Green® Boxwood* Zone 4-7 H 2-3' x W 3'

Hardy, compact variety of boxwood well suited for low and formal hedges. Retains its dark green foliage year-round. Needs some shade at our altitude.

Buxus 'Green Mountain' | *Green Mountain Boxwood* Zone 4-7 H 4' x W 3'

Fast grower when young and is naturally cone-shaped but is certainly suited for hedging and shearing. Small, bright green, evergreen leaves. Needs some shade at our altitude.

Buxus 'Green Velvet'® | *Green Velvet Boxwood* Zone 4-9 H 2-3' x W 3'

Low, rounded plant with dark green foliage year-round. Excellent for low, formal hedges.

Buxus 'Northern Charm' | *Northern Charm™ Boxwood* Zone 4-7 H 2-3'

Compact, oval habit. Semi-glossy emerald-green foliage develops bluish cast when growing. Rich, bronze-green in winter.

Caragana | Peashrub

Caragana arborescens | *Siberian Peashrub* Zone 2 H 12-15' x W 8-10'

Excellent choice for windbreaks, screens, hedges, and will adapt to poor soil conditions. Bright yellow pea-like flowers Full sun. Very tough shrub!

Caragana frutex 'Globosa' | *Globe Peashrub* Zone 3 H 2-3' x W 2-3'

Small dome shaped shrub with bright yellow flowers in May-June. Full sun

Caragana pygmaea | *Pygmy Peashrub* Zone 3 H 3-4' x W 3-4'

A low peashrub with bright yellow flowers in May-June Graceful foliated shrub that is an excellent plant for Cheyenne. Drought tolerant. Full sun.

Caryopteris | Spirea

Caryopteris x clandonensis | *Blue Mist Spirea* Zone 5 H 2-4' x W 2-3'

Beautiful light blue flowers appear in late July into August. Soft foliage and upright form make a beautiful accent to almost landscape. Treated more like a perennial here because it dies back to the ground. Full sun

Caryopteris x incana 'Dark Knight' | *Dark Knight Spirea* Zone 5 H 3-5' x W 2-3'

A newer introduction of the Blue Mist with darker gray-green foliage and darker blue flowers. Full sun.

Cercocarpus | Mahogany

Cercocarpus breviflorus | *Little Flowered Mountain Mahogany* Zone 4 H 6-12' x W 8-12'

A Great Basin native, this drought tolerant shrub can be grown as an evergreen in protected areas. Full sun with little maintenance.

Cercocarpus montanus | *True Mountain Mahogany* Zone 2 H 4-9' x W 4-6'

Open spreading shrub with grayish-green, wedge shaped leaves. Tiny yellow flowers in mid-spring produce fuzzy, twisted seed tails.

Chrysothamnus | Rabbitbrush

Chrysothamnus nauseosus | *Rabbitbrush* Zone 3 H 2-6' x W 2-6'

Native plains shrub that has gray foliage with bright yellow flowers. Very drought tolerant. Full sun

Chrysothamnus nauseosus albicaulis | *Tall Blue Rabbitbrush* Zone 3 H 4-6' x W 4-6'

Dense, flat topped clusters of small golden-yellow flowers in late summer. Full sun

Chrysothamnus nauseosus graveolens | *Tall Green Rabbitbrush* Zone 3 H 4-6' x W 4-6'

Similar to Tall Blue but with bright green color

Clethra | Summersweet

Clethra alnifolia 'Hummingbird' | *Hummingbird Summersweet* Zone 4-9 H 3-5' x W 3-4'

Wonderful native shrubs for moist, wet, or shaded sites. Compact variety with a dense, mounded form. Very fragrant white flower spikes mid summer.

Clethra alnifolia 'Ruby Spice' | *Ruby Spice Summersweet* Zone 4-9 H 3-5' x W 3-4'

Blue-green foliage with fragrant, intense pink flowers mid summer.

Cornus | Dogwood

Cornus alba 'Argenteo-Marginata' | *European Variegated Dogwood* Zone 3-7 H 6-10' x W 5-8'

Large, rounded shrub with bright red branches and variegated foliage.

Cornus alba 'Bailhalo' | Ivory Halo® Dogwood Zone 3-7 H 5-6' x W 5-6'
Compact form similar to 'Argenteo-Marginata'. Good for smaller spaces.

Cornus alba 'Bud's Yellow' | Bud's Yellow Dogwood Zone 3-7 H 6-8' x W 5-6'
Yellow-stemmed, nicely rounded shrub with attractive green foliage. Disease resistant.

Cornus baileyi | Red Twigged Dogwood Zone 2-7 H 8-10' x W 10'
Tough shrub for wet or shady sites, near large buildings, shrub borders, or naturalizing. Red stems and bluish-white fruits.

Cornus sericea 'Cardinal' | Cardinal Dogwood Zone 2-7 H 8-10' x W 10'
Selected for its bright scarlet-red winter twig color. Summer twigs are yellowish-green. This shrub is great for screening.

Cornus sericea 'Isanti' | Isanti Dogwood Zone 2-7 H 5-6' x W 8-10'
Slow growing, dense, red-twigged dogwood. Heavy fruiting is a good attraction for wildlife.

Cornus sericea 'Kelsey' | Kelsey Dwarf Dogwood Zone 4-8 H 5-6' x W 8-10'
Slow growing, dense, red-twigged dogwood. Heavy fruiting is a good attraction for wildlife.

Corylus | Hazel

Corylus americana | American Hazelnut Zone 4-9 H 6-10' x W 4-8'
Winter yellow catkins. A native naturalizing shrub with clusters of nuts in autumn. Great for wildlife and bright yellow fall foliage.

Cotinus | Smokebush

Cotinus coggygria 'Golden Spirit' | Golden Spirit Smokebush Zone 4-8 H 8' x W 6'
Really dense habit right from the ground. Bright yellow-green leaves turn orange-red in fall. Tiny pink flowers look like smoke.

Cotinus coggygria 'Royal Purple' | Royal Purple Smokebush Zone 4/5-8 H 8-10' x W 8-10'
Velvety purple leaves and misty beige flowers make this a dramatic accent for the landscape.

Cotinus coggygria 'Young Lady' | Young Lady Smokebush Zone 4-8 H 8-10' x W 8-10'
June-Aug pink Showy pink flowers from June to August with glossy green foliage that turns to excellent orange-red fall color.

Cotoneaster

Cotoneaster apiculatus | Cranberry Cotoneaster Zone 4/5-7 H 2' x W 3-6'
Dense, spreading shrub with arching branches and showy bright red berries late summer into winter. Useful for accent, foundation, or groundcover.

Cotoneaster dammeri 'Coral Beauty' | Coral Beauty Cotoneaster Zone 4 H 1-2' x W 3-6'

Glossy green leaves that are semi-evergreen. Showy, white flowers in late May followed by coral colored berries. Needs some protection. Part shade.

Cotoneaster divaricatus | Spreading Cotoneaster Zone 4 H 5-6' x W 6-8'

Spreading ornamental shrub with rose-pink flowers followed with dark red fruit. The leaves are glossy dark green. Red to purple fall color. Full sun to part shade.

Cotoneaster ignavus | Szechuan Fire Cotoneaster Zone 2-6 H 6-8' x W 4-6'

A selection of a cotoneaster found at the old Cheyenne Horticulture Station. Maroon fruits are smaller than those of the Peking. Full sun.

Cotoneaster lucidus | Peking or Hedge Cotoneaster Zone 2-6 H 8-10' x W 4-5'

Very upright plant excellent for hedges. Red fall foliage with black fruit.

Cytisus | Broom

Cytisus purgans 'Spanish Gold' | Spanish Gold Broom Zone 5 H 2-3' x W 4-6'

Dense upright shrub with bright yellow flowers. Native to Spain that makes a great winter interest shrub. Full sun to shade.

Cytisus scoparius 'Moonlight' | Moonlight Broom Zone 5 H 4-6' x W 4-6'

A rounded broom with slender, slightly drooping, green branches lightly covered in small, narrow, bright green leaves. Yellow flowers bloom in late spring to early summer. Minimal winterkill. Full sun to part shade.

Daphne

Daphne burkwoodii 'Carol Mackie' | Carol Mackie Daphne Zone 4-7 H 2-3' x W 3-4'

Prolific bloomer covered with clusters of fragrant pink ½" flowers late spring. Striking variegated foliage on a dense mounded shape.

Diervilla | Bush Honeysuckle

Diervilla lonicera | Dwarf Bush Honeysuckle Zone 3-7 H 4' x W 3-4'

Tough, little shrub with bronze-green foliage used for naturalizing, slopes, or mass plantings. Small yellow flowers late spring. Tolerates shade; red fall color.

Diervilla sessilifolia 'Butterfly' | Butterfly Bush Honeysuckle Zone 4-7 H 3-5' x W 3-5'

Rich yellow flowers early summer with bright green foliage. Neat habit. Adapts to dry shade but prefers full sun to part sun.

Ephedra | Bluestem Joint Fir

Ephedra equisetina | *Bluestem Joint Fir* Zone 5 H 3-4' x W 5-6'

Unique mounding shrub with upright, slender blue stems, which are the leaflets. Striking accent plant for any landscape. Good xeris cape plant.

Euonymus | Burning Bush

Euonymus alatus | *Burning Bush* Zone 3-8 H 10-12' x W 8-12'

Large, rounded shrub for borders and screens. Long-lasting red fall color with corky bark for winter interest.

Euonymus alatus 'Compactus' | *Dwarf Burning Bush* Zone 4-8 H 5-6' x W 5-8'

Dwarf form of the species. Bushy with brilliant red fall color and corky bark. Good accent plant.

Exochorda | Pearlbush

Exochorda serratifolia 'Northern Pearls' | *Northern Pearls Burning Bush* Zone 4 H 6-8' x W 4-5'

A Korean native that is covered with white flower racemes in late May to June that resemble a string of pearls. Flower open to a 2" diameter.

Fallugia

Fallugia paradoxa | *Apache Plume* Zone 3 H 3-5' x W 3-5'

Small densely branched shrub with small scale-like gray green foliage. White flowers all summer. Feathery plume-like seed heads.

Forsythia

Forsythia 'Courtasol' | *Gold Tide™ Forsythia* Zone 4-8 H 2-3' x W 3-4'

Compact, ground-hugging habit from France. Excellent for mass plantings. Blooms lemon yellow in early spring. Not tolerant of dry soils. Needs adequate snow cover for consistent spring bloom.

Forsythia 'Fiesta' | *Fiesta Forsythia* Zone 4-8 H 3-6' x W 3-5'

Variiegated bright yellow and green foliage with red stems. Golden yellow flowers early spring.

Forsythia 'Northern Sun' | *Northern Sun Forsythia* Zone 3-8 H 8-10' x W 7-9'

Spectacular, clear yellow flowers in late April. Vigorous grower for screens, hedges, and borders. U of M introduction.

Forsythia intermedia 'Spring Glory' | *Spring Glory Forsythia* Zone 4-8 H 6-8' x W 6-8'

Heavy blooming habit is covered with large, pale-yellow flowers in April. Upright with slight arching form. Rust resistant.

Hamamelis | Witch Hazel

Hamamelis virginiana | Common Witch Hazel Zone 4-8 H 15' x W 12-15'

Large, native shrub that is a well rounded vase-shaped plant. Fragrant, yellow, ribbon-like flowers appear late in fall. Golden yellow fall foliage. Tolerates shade and moisture.

Hydrangea

Hydrangea arborescens 'Annabelle' | Annabelle Smooth Hydrangea Zone 3-9 H 4-5' x W 3-5'

summer white Improved selection with large, round, white flower heads mid-summer. Thrives in shade.

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Blushing Bride' | Blushing Bride Hydrangea Zone 4/5-9 H 3-5' x W 3-5' summer light pink. A macrophylla hydrangea that blooms on new and old wood. Light pink flowers with dark green foliage make this an attractive plant.

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bailmer' | Endless Summer® Hydrangea Zone 4-9 H 3' x W 3' summer blue/pink

A showy mop-head hydrangea with the ability to bloom on new and old wood. Flowers tend to be pink on native soils but will turn or stay blue in acidic conditions (pH 6 or less).

Hydrangea paniculata 'Grandiflora' | PeeGee Hydrangea Zone 3-8 H 8' x W 10-15'

Upright, mounded shrub with showy, white conical shaped flowers in July and August that fade to pink-bronze. Useful in dried arrangements.

Hydrangea paniculata 'Limelight' | Limelight hydrangea Zone 3-8 H 6-8' x W 6-8'

New plant that produces exquisite bright lime green flowers midsummer. Excellent vigor and floriferous blooming. Flowers on new wood.

Hydrangea paniculata 'Pink Diamond' | Pink Diamond Hydrangea Zone 3-8 H 6-8' x W 6-8'

Huge (up to 10") pink flower buds open white in late summer then quickly mature to a rich, deep pink. A beautiful specimen for the landscape.

Hydrangea paniculata 'Tardiva' | Late Panicle Hydrangea Zone 3-8 H 6-8' x W 8-10' late summer white

Similar to 'PeeGee' but blooms later in the season with larger flower panicles.

Hydrangea paniculata 'Unique' | Unique PeeGee Hydrangea Zone 3-8 H 6-10' x W 6-10'

Large plant that resembles 'PeeGee' in most aspects. The flower panicles are larger and make a superior display.

Ligustrum | Privet

Ligustrum vulgare 'Cheyenne' | Cheyenne Privet Zone 4-8 H 4-5' x W 5-6'

Hardest hedging privet for Cheyenne with small white flowers mid summer and glossy, dark green foliage. Fruit is poisonous. Thousands upon thousands of this specimen have been sold throughout the United States, all of which originally came from the parent plant at the old Cheyenne Horticulture Station.

Ligustrum vulgare 'Lodense' | Lodense Privet Zone 4-8 H 3-5' x W 2-4'

Ideal for a low hedge. Compact, dense form with glossy, deep green foliage. White flowers with poisonous fruit. Needs protection full sun to part shade

Lonicera | Honeysuckle

Lonicera 'Honeyrose' | Honeyrose Honeysuckle Zone 4-7 H 10' x W 8-10'

University of Minnesota introduction with rosy red flowers early to mid summer and deep blue-green foliage that is resistant to Honeysuckle witches broom aphid. Works well as a barrier, screen, or informal hedge.

Lonicera periclymenum 'Honeybush' | Honeybush Honeysuckle Zone 4-8 H 2' x W 4'

Groundcover form with sprays of old fashioned honeysuckle flowers of red and cream adorn the plant. Fragrant with plump purple fall foliage. Prefers well-drained soil.

Lonicera xylosteum 'Emerald Mound' | Emerald Mound Honeysuckle Zone 4-8 H 2-3' x W 4-6'

Nicely mounded shrub that leafs out very early in the spring. Red berries in fall. Drought tolerant.

Mahonia | Grape Holly

Mahonia aquifolium | Oregon Grape Holly Zone 5 H 4-6' x W 4-6'

Yellow flowers followed by blue berries in fall. Leaves turn red in fall, bronzed in winter. Needs shade & some protection.

Mahonia aquifolium 'Compacta' | Oregon Grape Compact Holly Zone 5 H 2-3' x W 3'

Dwarf form of Oregon Grape Holly. Yellow flowers in spring followed by blue

Perovskia | Russian Sage

Perovskia atriplicifolia | Russian Sage Zone 5 H 3-4' x W 3-4'

Finely cut, grayish-green leaves on a dense, compact shrub. Bright blue flower spikes appear mid to late summer. Prune back heavily in fall.

Philadelphus | Mockorange

Philadelphus coronarius 'Aureus' | Golden Mockorange Zone 4-8 H 3-6' x W 4-5'

Fragrant, single white flowers early summer with golden foliage. Upright globe in form.

Philadelphus lewisii 'Blizzard' | Blizzard Mockorange Zone 3-7 H 4-5' x W 3'

Profuse clusters of fragrant, single white blooms early to mid summer lasting up to 4 weeks.

Philadelphus lewisii 'Cheyenne' | Cheyenne Mockorange Zone 3 H 4-6' x W 4-5'

Broadly rounded to upright selection out of the Cheyenne Research Station, having dense racemes of pure white flowers.

Physocarpus | Ninebark

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Nana' | Dwarf Ninebark Zone 2 H 4-6' x W 4-6'

White flowers in May and June that turn into red seed pods. Good choice for hedges.

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Coppertina' | Coppertina Ninebark Zone 3 H 6-8' x W 3-4'

Upright, vase shaped shrub that has copper colored new growth and turns into a rich red as it matures.

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Dart's Gold' | Dart's Gold Ninebark Zone 2-7 H 4-5' x W 4-5'

Hardy, attractive shrub with golden foliage, white flowers, and red fruit. For foundations or border. Vigorous grower.

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Diabolo'® | Diabolo Ninebark Zone 3-7 H 8-10' x W 8-10' June white

Beautiful purple-burgundy leaves cover this easy to grow shrub that quickly becomes a nicely mounded accent for foundations and borders. Creamy white flowers stand out against dark foliage.

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Summer Wine'® | Summer Wine Ninebark Zone 3-7 H 4-6' x W 4-6'

May-June pink/white. Dense, compact habit with finely cut wine colored foliage.

Potentilla | Cinquefoil

Potentilla fruticosa 'Abbotswood' | Abbotswood Potentilla Zone 2-7 H 2-3' x W 2-3'

White flowers from spring to fall on a dense, spreading shrub. Good selection for low hedges.

Compact variety with large deep golden flowers produced profusely all season

Potentilla fruticosa 'Gold Drop' | Gold Drop Potentilla Zone 2-7 H 2-4' x W 2-4'

Another excellent foundation shrub with showy golden flowers all season on a compact, mounded plant.

Potentilla fruticosa 'Goldfinger' | Goldfinger Potentilla Zone 2-7 H 3' x W 3-4'

Another excellent foundation shrub with showy golden flowers all season on a compact, mounded plant.

Potentilla fruticosa 'Jackmannii' | Jackmann Potentilla Zone 2 H 3-5 x W 3-5'

Upright grower. Continuous blooming large bright yellow blooms.

Potentilla fruticosa 'Mango Tango'™ | Mango Tango Potentilla Zone 2-7 H 2' x W 2'

Season long flowering on a compact, mounded plant. Flowers are orange-red with yellow edges. The color deepens in cooler weather and softens in warm weather.

Potentilla fruticosa 'McKay's White' | McKay's White Potentilla Zone 2-7 H 2-2.5' x W 2-3'

A sport of Katherine Dyke with creamy white flowers. Good alternate to Abbotswood .

Potentilla fruticosa 'Pink Beauty' | Pink Beauty Potentilla Zone 2-7 H 3-4' x W 3-4'
Bright green foliage is bushy and full. Prolific blooms of clear pink.

Potentilla fruticosa 'Snowbird' | Snowbird Potentilla Zone 2-7 H 2-3' x W 2-3'
Double white flowers and glossy green foliage.

Prunus

Prunus besseyi | Western Sandcherry Zone 2 H 5-6' x W 5-6'
Hardy shrub for challenging areas. Fragrant blooms followed by edible fruit. Red fall color. Xeriscape plant.

Prunus besseyi 'Pawnee Buttes' | Western Sandcherry Zone 3 H 15-18" x W 4-6'
A ground covering form of sand cherry with lustrous green leaves and good fall color. Flowers are followed by black berries in summer. Bird magnet.

Prunus glandulosa' Rosea Plena' | Pink Flowering Almond Zone 4 H 4-5' x W 3-4'
Double blossoms on stems before the spring foliage emerges marks the start of spring in Wyoming. Green foliage throughout the summer.

Prunus tenella | Dwarf Russian Almond Zone 2 H 2-5' x W 3-5'
Low suckering shrub with slender glossy green leaves. ½" long very showy pink flowers in early spring. Great for cold climates. Full sun.

Prunus tomentosa | Nanking Cherry Zone 2-6 H 8-10' x W 10-15'
Excellent choice for borders, naturalizing, or large accent plant. Fragrant, white flowers bloom early on shrub with reddish, exfoliating bark. Edible fruit.

Prunus triloba | Double Flowering Plum Zone 2-6 H 8-10' x W 8'
Large 1" diameter double flowers in April and May. For best blooms plant in a wind protected area.

Prunus virginiana(melanocarpa) | Western Chokecherry Zone 3 H 10-12' x W 10'
Shrub or small tree. Fragrant, pendulous spring flowers followed by red fruit that matures black. Great for birds.

Prunus virginiana 'Canada Red' | Canada Red Chokecherry (shrub form) Zone 2 H 20-25' x W 20-25'
New growth is green, turning maroon-red as leaves mature. Pendulous, fragrant spring flowers and dark edible fruits in mid-summer attract birds. Very hardy.

Prunus x cistena | Purpleleaf Sand Cherry Zone 3-8 H 6-8' x W 5-6'
Intense reddish-purple leaves all summer, small fragrant pink flowers in spring. An upright, oval shrub for borders or accent.

Rhamnus frangula 'Aspenifolia' | Fern Leaf Buckthorn Zone 2 H 12-15' x W 8-10'
An unusual cut-leaf variety of very fine-texture. A handsome plant.

Rhamnus frangula 'Columnaris' | Fern Leaf Buckthorn Zone 2 H 8-10' x W 4'

Narrow, tall shrub with glossy leaves and clusters of black berries. Interesting bark. Drought resistant when established. Good for hedges.

Rhus | Sumac

Rhus aromatica 'Gro-Low' | Gro-Low Fragrant Sumac Zone 3-8 H 2.5' x W 6-8'

Low growing, wide spreading selection of fragrant sumac with excellent orange-scarlet fall color. Does not resemble other sumacs; great for mass plantings or erosion control on banks. Salt-tolerant.

Rhus glabra | Smooth Sumac Zone 3-8 H 10' x W 10'

Smooth branching and wide-spreading habit. Beautiful red fall foliage. Has suckering habit that makes it good for banks, screens, and mass plantings.

Rhus glabra 'Laciniata' | Cutleaf Smooth Sumac Zone 3-8 H 8' x W 6-8'

Similar to the species with more finely divided leaves.

Rhus typhina 'Bailtiger' | Tiger Eyes® Cutleaf Staghorn Sumac (PPAF) Zone 4-8 H 6' x W 6'

New growth is chartreuse green quickly changing to bright yellow with rosy pink leaf stems. Branches angle upward while deeply cut golden leaves drape downward giving an oriental effect. Dramatic yellow, orange, and intense scarlet fall color.

Rhus typhina 'Laciniata' | Cutleaf Staghorn Sumac Zone 3-8 H 10' x W 12-15'

Velvety branches on a wide-spreading Sumac. Fabulous fall color and finely divided leaves. Crimson berries in fall.

Ribes | Currant

Ribes alpinum | Alpine Currant Zone 2-7 H 3-5' x W 5-6'

Very popular hedge plant with dense glossy green foliage.

Ribes alpinum 'Green Mound' | Green Mound Alpine Currant Zone 2-7 H 3' x W 3'

Deep glossy green foliage with good disease resistance. Slower growth rate and somewhat horizontal branching may make this plant a good choice for a low hedge.

Rubus | Thimbleberry

Rubus deliciosus | Thimbleberry Zone 2 H 3-5' x W 5'

Large single flowers from May to June on this bright green deciduous shrub. Fruit is seedy and not edible. Nice exfoliating bark. Native xeriscape plant

Salix | Willow

Salix caprea | French Pussy Willow Zone 4-8 H 15-20' x W 12-15'

Large shrub/small tree that tolerates full sun and moist soil. Large silvery catkins appear in early spring before the leaves.

Salix integra 'Hakura Nishiki' | Nishiki Willow Zone 4-7 H 4-8' x W 4-8'

Small shrub that bears pink stems that are covered with narrow leaves beautifully dappled green, pink, and white.

Salix purpurea 'Nana' | Dwarf Blue Leaf Arctic Willow Zone 4-6 H 3-4' x W 3-6'

Upright, rounded shrub useful for wet areas or as a hedge. Twigs turn purplish in winter.

Sambucus | Elderberry

Sambucus nigra 'Black Beauty' | Black Beauty Elderberry Zone 4-7 H 8-10' x W 8-10' May-June white
Fast growing elder with striking dark purple-black foliage. Blooms rich pink, lemon scented flowers in June. Full sun.

Sambucus nigra 'Eva' | Black Lace™ Elderberry Zone 4-7 H 8-10' x W 8-10'

May-June white. Dark purple, finely cut foliage has an exotic appeal usually found only in Japanese maples. Pink buds open to lacy white blossoms. An excellent specimen plant.

Sambucus nigra 'Madonna' | Madonna Elderberry Zone 4-7 H 8-10' x W 8-10'

Variegated yellow and green foliage all summer long. Large, 6-10" white flowers in spring. Great contrast plant.

Shepherdia argentea | Buffaloberry Zone 2 H 8-10' x W 8'

A thorny shrub with silvery foliage and orange-red fruits. Extremely tolerant of drought, cold, and alkaline soil.

Sorbaria | False Spirea

Sorbaria sorbifolia | Ash Leaf Spirea Zone 2-7 H 6-8' x W 5-10'

Clump-forming shrub that's very useful in screens, borders, and mass plantings early summer. Flowers are creamy white plumes. Prefers moist, well-drained soil.

Spiraea | Spirea

Spiraea albiflora | Japanese White Spirea Zone 3-8 H 2' x W 2'

Compact, rounded shrub for foundations or small areas. Clusters of white flowers summer into fall. Blooms on new wood, remove spent flowers to encourage re-bloom.

Spiraea japonica 'Alpina' | Daphne Spirea Zone 4-8 H 12" x W 2-3' June pink

Small blue-green leaves on short wiry branches with clusters of light pink flowers. Remove spent flowers to encourage season long color.

Spiraea japonica 'Goldmound' | Goldmound Spirea Zone 3-8 H 2' x W 2-3'

Superb foundation plant. Yellow/gold foliage and pink flowers. Reddish fall foliage. Beautiful when contrasted with dark green or blue toned shrubs.

Spiraea japonica 'Little Princess' | Little Princess Spirea Zone 3-8 H 2' x W 3'

Very popular pink flowering Spiraea with a low-mounded habit and medium green foliage that turns a dark burgundy red in the fall. Remove spent flowers to encourage season long color.

Spiraea japonica 'Magic Carpet' | Magic Carpet™ Spirea Zone 3-8 H 2' x W 2'

Compact, mounded with red-tipped new growth with a backdrop of golden foliage. Clusters of deep pink flowers early summer.

Spiraea japonica 'Neon Flash' | Neon Flash Spirea Zone 4-8 H 3' x W 3'

Vigorous growth habit that is covered with bright red flower clusters throughout the growing season. New growth is tinged purple before turning to green. Fall foliage is an attractive burgundy-red color.

Spiraea japonica 'Shiobana' | Shiori Spirea Zone 4 H 2-3' x W 3-4'

A Spirea with beautiful tri-colored flowers in early spring of white, rose, and pink. Rich green foliage.

Spiraea nipponica 'Snowmound' | Snowmound Spirea Zone 4-8 H 3-5' x W 3-5'

Dark green foliage on a medium-sized, rounded shrub with many pure white flowers late spring. Fall foliage color is ablaze with yellow, orange, and red.

Spiraea x bumalda 'Anthony Waterer' | Anthony Waterer Spirea Zone 4-8 H 2-3' x W 4-5'

Useful in mass plantings and low flowering hedges. Rosy-red flowers from early summer into the fall. Remove spent flowers to encourage heavier re-bloom. Attractive reddish-purple fall foliage color.

Spiraea x bumalda 'Goldflame' | Goldflame Spirea Zone 3-8 H 2-3' x W 3-4'

Low mounded shrub with gold to light green foliage. Rosy-red flowers recur all season. Brilliant red new growth changes to golden yellow then to green. Fall foliage may show shades of burgundy and reds.

Spiraea x vanhouttei 'Renaissance' | Renaissance Spirea Zone 3-7 H 5-7' x W 6-8'

Large, vase-shaped shrub with dark blue-green foliage and arching sprays of white flowers in May. Orange-red fall color.

Symphoricarpos

Symphoricarpos doorenbosii 'Kordes' | Amethyst™ Coralberry Zone 3-7 H 3-5' x W 3-5'

Incredibly deep colored purple-pink fruit in late summer. Keeps its form; doesn't spread.

Symphoricarpos orbiculatus | Red Snowberry, Indiancurrant Zone 4-7 H 2-5' x W 4-8'

Best used in 'tough' areas for erosion control on banks, in wet areas, or for naturalizing. Produces very ornamental purplish-red berries.

Syringa laciniata | Cutleaf Lilac Zone 4-8 H 6-8' x W 6-8' single, pale lilac

Lacy, small lobed foliage that's truly elegant. Resists mildew and quite heat tolerant. Blooms in spring with 3" panicles all along the stems.

Syringa meyeri 'Palibin' | Dwarf Korean Lilac Zone 3-7 H 4-5' x W 5-7'

Very fragrant, single lilac-pink flowers open mid to late spring and fade to light pink with age. A dwarf by lilac standards, this plant is suited for an informal mid-sized hedge.

Syringa 'Miss Canada' | Miss Canada Lilac Zone 2-7 H 6-9' x W 5-8'

One of the last lilacs to flower, this hardy, vigorous, nonsuckering variety has bright rose-pink colored flowers. Often used as a specimen plant.

Syringa patula 'Miss Kim' | Miss Kim Lilac Zone 3-7 H 6-7' x W 5-6'

Hardy with purple buds that open to highly fragrant, pale lilac flowers. Large leaves with beautiful burgundy-red fall color. Makes an excellent formal or informal hedge.

Syringa vulgaris | Common Purple Lilac Zone 2-7 H 12-15' x 8-12'

Old-fashioned lilac perfect as an informal hedge or screen. Extremely fragrant purple flowers. Cut flowers hold up well.

Syringa vulgaris 'Adelaide Dunbar' | Adelaide Dunbar Lilac Zone 3 H 10-12' x W 8-12'

Excellent variety of lilac with very fragrant, double, deep purple flowers.

Syringa vulgaris 'Albert F. Holden' | Albert F. Holden Lilac Zone 3-7 H 7' x W 8'

Deep violet blooms possess a silvery blush on reverse of the petals giving a bicolor effect. Large flower panicles with a nice fragrance. Resistant to powdery mildew.

Syringa vulgaris 'Charles Joly' | Charles Joly Lilac Zone 3-7 H 10-12' x W 8-10'

Fragrant smaller panicles of purple buds that turn to magenta double flowers.

Syringa vulgaris 'Beauty of Moscow' | Beauty of Moscow Lilac Zone 3-7 H 10-12' x W 8'

A vigorous, upright lilac with light pink buds opening to fragrant, double white flowers on abundant panicles.

Syringa vulgaris 'Monge' | Monge Lilac Zone 3-7 H 10-12' x W 8-12'

Very showy single, reddish-purple flowers are held on long stems that lend themselves to great cut flowers.

Syringa vulgaris 'Prairie Petite' | Prairie Petite Lilac Zone 3-7 H 3-4' x W 3'

Unique dwarf, compact form of lilac. Initial color of newly opened flowers is light pink which fade to light lavender. Blooms are 3 to 4" long. Heat and drought tolerant and disease resistant.

Syringa vulgaris 'Sensation' | Sensation Lilac Zone 3-7 H 8-10' x W 8-12'

Purple florets outlined in pure white. A beautiful and unique lilac.

Syringa vulgaris var. alba | Common White Lilac Zone 2 H 12-15' x W 8-12'

Old-fashioned, hardy, vigorous shrub with single white blooms. Attractive foliage. Use as an informal hedge or screen.

Viburnum

Viburnum dentatum 'Christom' | Blue Muffin® Arrowwood Viburnum Zone 3-9 H 5-6' x W 5-6'

Spring white. Compact selection of Arrowwood Viburnum with loads of white flowers followed by very attractive blue berries during the summer months that will attract birds in the fall.

Viburnum dentatum 'Morton' | Northern Burgundy® Arrowwood Viburnum Zone 4-8 H 10-12' x W 10-12'

May white Arrowwood Viburnum with improved red fall color. Abundant white flowers followed by blue fruit that will attract birds as summer turns to fall. Excellent as a hedge or screen.

Viburnum dentatum 'Ralph Senior' | Autumn Jazz® Arrowwood Viburnum Zone 4-8 H 10-12' x W 8-10'

May-June creamy white. Arrowwood selection with excellent shape and form. Clusters of blue-black fruit follow creamy white flowers. Fall color ranges from yellow, orange, red, and burgundy.

Viburnum lantana 'Mohican' | Mohican Viburnum Zone 3-7 H 6' x W 6-8'

Compact globe form of the species, covered in creamy white flowers in early May. Purple-bronze fall colored foliage. Excellent for hedge or screen. Orange-red fruit in summer.

Viburnum lentago | Nannyberry Viburnum Zone 2-8 H 20' x W 8-15' June white

Very large, creamy white flower clusters explode against glossy green foliage. In autumn, the pendulous blue-black fruits glisten against reddish-purple leaves. Excellent winter food source for birds. Tolerates heavy, wet soils.

Viburnum opulus 'Compactum' | Compact European Snowball Zone 3-8 H 5' x W 5-6'

Medium-sized, rounded shrub. White spring flowers are followed by showy red fruit late summer lasting well into fall.

Viburnum opulus 'Nanum' | Dwarf European Cranberry Bush Zone 4-8 H 2-3' x W 2-4'

Dwarf form of 'Compactum'. Foundation or low hedge plant requires no pruning. Rarely flowers.

Viburnum opulus 'Roseum' | Common Snowball Viburnum Zone 3-8 H 10-12' x W 10-12'

Popular, rounded shrub blooms profusely in spring with large, double, white flowers. Very showy.

Viburnum sargentii 'Onondaga' | Onondaga Viburnum Zone 3 H 6-8' x W 6-8' Spring white/purple

Foliage that emerges velvety maroon then matures to deep green. Flat rosettes of purple-tinged flowers in spring followed with showy red fruit and foliage in the fall.

Viburnum trilobum 'Bailey Compact' | Bailey Compact American Cranberry Zone 2-7 H 5-6' x W 5-6'

White. Compact rounded form of species with excellent deep red fall color. An excellent choice for foundation plantings.

Weigela florida 'Wine and Roses'® | *Wine and Roses Weigela* Zone 4-8 H 4-5' x W 3-5'

Intense rosy-pink flowers shimmer against dark foliage that emerges deep burgundy-purple and intensifies to nearly black.

Weigela florida 'French Lace'™ | *French Lace Weigela* Zone 4-8 H 4-5' x W 4-5'

Hardier, variegated Weigela. Green leaves with yellow margins and dark red flowers.

Weigela florida 'Carnaval'® | *Carnaval Weigela* Zone 4-8 H 4-5' x W 3-5'

Unique tri-colored effect with pink, white, and red blossoms over an extended period of late spring through early summer.

Weigela florida 'Minuet' | Minuet Weigela Zone 4-8 H 24-30" x W 2-3'

Dwarf plant that's hardier than other dwarf cultivars. Blooms freely in late spring with ruby-red flowers, lilac petal lobes, and yellow throats. Great foundation shrub. Slight fragrance.

Weigela florida 'My Monet'™ | *My Monet Weigela* Zone 4-8 H 12-18" x W 12-15" purplish pink

This Weigela has a compact habit and colorful foliage. Versatile shrub is attractive in annual beds or in perennial borders.

Weigela florida 'Polka' | Polka Weigela Zone 4-8 H 3-4' x W 4-5' May-June pink

Canadian introduction that's generally accepted as the best pink Weigela. Compact, rounded with thick dark green leaves. Profuse bloomer with pink flowers.

Weigela florida 'Red Prince' | Red Prince Weigela Zone 4-8 H 5-6' x W 5-6' spring red

Very hardy, upright shrub with brilliant red flowers that hold their color well. Tendency to rebloom in late summer.
