# Deciduous Trees

## Acer | Maple

*Acer freemanii* 'Autumn Blaze'® | Autumn Blaze Maple Zone 4-7 H 50-60' x W 40'

A hybrid between red and silver maple that is drought and moisture tolerant, has excellent orange-red fall color, good branching habit, and is a fast grower.

*Acer ginnala* 'Flame' | Flame Amur Maple Zone 3-7 H 15-20' x W 20-25'

A small, dense form of Amur maple selected for bright red fruits, fiery red fall color. A hardy plant that does well in shade.

*Acer negundo* 'Sensation' | Sensation Boxelder Zone 2 H 30-40' x W 25-35'

Very tolerant of harsh alkaline soils and environments. Seedless male clone that does not attract boxelder bugs.

*Acer platanoides* 'Royal Red' | Royal Red Norway Maple Zone 4-7 H 35-40' x W 25'

Attractive glossy, maroon-red foliage all summer long with a nice full crown.

*Acer rubrum* 'Red Sunset'® | Red Sunset Maple Zone 4-7 H 50' x W 30-40'

This dense, upright red maple retains its leaves and red fall color longer than most other selections. In summer, the trees are covered with heavily textured, bright green leaves. Excellent choice for streets or lawns.

*Acer rubrum* 'Northwood' | Northwood Red Maple Zone 3-8 50' x 35'

A choice selection of red maple with a beautiful, rounded crown, an excellent growth habit, and good early fall color.

*Acer tataricum* 'Pattern Perfect' | Pattern Perfect Tatarian Maple Zone 3 H 15-20' x W 15'

This small, useful maple has a dense, oval, upright form. Undemanding and tolerates cold winters, alkaline soil, and drought. The thick green leaves turn orange-red in fall. Light fragrance.

## Aesculus | Buckeye

*Aesculus glabra* | Ohio Buckeye Zone 3 H 25-35' x W 20-35'

Broadly rounded tree with palmate leaves. Flowers in upright panicles give way to spiny fruit later in the summer. Brilliant fall color.

## **Amelanchier | Serviceberry**

*Amelanchier grandiflora 'Autumn Brilliance' | Autumn Brilliance™ Serviceberry* Zone 3-8 H 20-25' x W 15'  
One of the loveliest small trees for Minnesota. Clouds of white blossoms in May. The sweet, edible fruit are bird magnets. Blue/green leaves with brilliant red fall color and attractive gray bark. Foundation, accent, border, or screen.

## **Celtis | Hackberry**

*Celtis occidentalis | Common Hackberry* Zone 2-7 H 50-75' x W 50'  
Interesting rough, corky, bark and yellowish fall foliage; spreading, rounded form.

## **Crataegus | Hawthorn**

*Crataegus ambigua | Russian Hawthorn* Zone 3 H 15-25' x W 20'  
A very hardy variety of Hawthorn (has thorns) with branches that have a twisting habit. Flowers appear in spring; red berries hang on into winter and attract birds.

*Crataegus crus-galli var. inermis | Thornless Cockspur Hawthorn* Zone 4-7 H 15-20' x W 15-20'  
Rounded, spreading crown with leathery, glossy, dark green leaves. Tree is smothered in June with pretty white flowers. Good orange fall color and red fruit.

*Crataegus x mordenensis 'Toba' | Toba Hawthorn* Zone 4-7 H 12-15' x W 15-20'  
Fragrant large double white flowers mature to Pink. Fruits are red ½", sparse. Attractive yellow bark and interesting twisted trunk.

## **Fraxinus | Ash**

*Fraxinus americana 'Autumn Purple' | Autumn Purple® White Ash* Zone 4-8 H 50-60' x W 30-40'  
An excellent street and lawn tree with rapid growth, deep purple fall color. Tolerates moist soil and is seedless.

*Fraxinus nigra 'Fallgold' | Fallgold Ash* Zone 3-6 H 50-60' x W 40'  
A broad, oval, truly seedless selection of the black ash. Vigorous with yellow fall color.  
*Fraxinus mandshurica 'Mancana' | Mancana Ash* Zone 3 H 40' x W 25'  
Excellent medium-sized xeric tree offering sharply pointed, narrow leaves in the summer and bright yellow fall color.

*Fraxinus pennsylvanica 'Marshall's Seedless' | Marshall's Seedless Ash* Zone 4 H 50' x W 35'  
Round symmetrical form. Good for street and lawn planting. Normally seedless.

*Fraxinus pennsylvanica 'Patmore' | Patmore Green Ash* Zone 2-7 H 50-60' x W 35'  
Upright, branching with oval crown. Hardy, disease free, and seedless. Yellow fall foliage. Tolerates drought.

*Fraxinus pennsylvanica 'Patmore' | Patmore Green Ash Zone 2-7 H 50-60' x W 35'*

Upright, branching with oval crown. Hardy, disease free, and seedless. Yellow fall foliage. Tolerates drought.

*Fraxinus pennsylvanica 'Summit' Summit Ash Zone 4 H 50' x W 20'*

This vigorous, fast-growing selection of Green Ash features a very straight trunk and uniformly upright habit.

### **Gleditsia | Honeylocust**

*Gleditsia triacanthos var. inermis 'Imperial'® | Imperial Honeylocust Zone 4-7 H 30-35' x W 30-35'*

Strong, graceful, spreading variety that has dainty, refined foliage of bright green that adds to its ornamental appeal.

*Gleditsia triacanthos inermis 'Shademaster' | Shademaster Honeylocust Zone 4 H 60' x W 45'*

Large grower known for its strong straight trunk, symmetrical ascending branches, and dark green pinnately compound foliage.

*Gleditsia triacanthos var. inermis 'Skyline'® | Skyline Honeylocust Zone 4-7 H 50' x W 30-35'*

Distinctly pyramidal with nicely shaped crown; thornless. Excellent choice for filtered sun, light shade. Golden fall color .

*Gleditsia triacanthos var. inermis 'Sunburst'® | Sunburst Honeylocust Zone 4-7 H 35' x W 30-35'*

Smaller than 'Skycole' and with an irregularly rounded crown. Foliage golden/yellow in spring & fall. Casts filtered shade

### **Malus | Crabapple**

*Malus 'Adams' | Adams Flowering Crab Zone 4-8 H 25' x W 20'*

Rounded crown, single pink flowers, persistent carmine-red fruit, highly rated disease resistance. Orange-red fall color

*Malus 'Coralburst'® | Coralburst Flowering Crab Zone 3-7 H 8-10' x W 12-15'*

This is a uniform and small-growing tree with a compact rounded crown. Very scab-resistant foliage and lovely semi-double pink flowers.

*Malus sargentii 'Firebird'® | Firebird Flowering Crab Zone 4-7 H 5' x W 8'*

A scab-resistant dwarf sargentii-type crab. Very slow-growing- 5' in 20 years. A nice globe-shaped crown, white flowers in spring and persistent dark red fruits for winter interest.

*Malus 'Louisa' | Louisa Flowering Crab Zone 4-7 H 15' x W 15'*

Attractive, pink-flowered weeping crab. Good to excellent disease resistance. Dark green foliage and persistent yellow fruit. The unique branching makes this tree a nice focal point in a garden landscape.

*Malus 'Pink Spires' | Pink Spires Flowering Crab Zone 2-7 H 15-20' x W 12-15'*  
Narrow, upright tree with pink flowers and persistent purplish-red fruit.

*Malus 'Prairefire' | Prairefire Flowering Crab Zone 4-7 H 15-20' x W 20'*  
Red buds open to bright rosy-red flowers. Glossy reddish-green foliage reflects in bright summer sunshine to catch ones eye. Persistent maroon fruit will dry over winter and attract hungry birds the following spring. Excellent disease resistance help make this tree an outstanding ornamental.

*Malus 'Purple Prince' | Purple Prince Flowering Crab Zone 4-7 H 20' x W 20'*  
More symmetrical than Prairefire with excellent scab and rust resistance. Purple foliage that rivals Prairefire with red flowers and maroon fruit.

*Malus 'Red Barron' | Red Barron Flowering Crab Zone 4-7 H 12-15' x W 5-6'*  
Use this narrow, columnar crab selection where space is limited in urban situations. Attractive purple-bronze foliage with dark red fruit on red flowers.

*Malus 'Red Jewel'™ | Red Jewel Flowering Crab Zone 4-7 H 15' x W 12'*  
A beautiful white flowering crab with persistent showy red fruit. Upright, pyramidal crown, dark green foliage, along with good disease resistance makes this crabapple a year round beauty.

*Malus 'Red Splendor' | Red Splendor Flowering Crab Zone 3-7 H 20-25' x W 20'*  
Open, upright, spreading habit. Pink flowers, persistent red fruit.

*Malus 'Royalty' | Royalty Flowering Crab Zone 3-7 H 18-20' x W 20'*  
Upright, rounded crown, dark red flowers, dark red fruit, and beautiful glossy burgundy foliage. Orange fall color, very hardy and blight-resistant.

*Malus sargentii 'Tina' | Sargent Tina Flowering Crab Zone 4-7 H 6-8' x W 8-10'*  
Bright red buds become single white flowers on this small crabapple with a horizontal, spreading habit. Good disease-resistant variety for small spaces.

*Malus 'Snowdrift' | Snowdrift Flowering Crab Zone 3-7 H 15-20' x W 20-25'*  
An outstanding white flowering crab that is hardy and low-maintenance. Persistent orange-red fruit that attracts and is eaten by birds.

*Malus 'Spring Snow' | Spring Snow Flowering Crab Zone 4-7 H 25-30' x W 15'*  
Rounded to oval crown is covered with a profusion of white flowers in spring. Does not produce fruit.

## **Physocarpus | Ninebark**

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Monlo' Tree Form | Diablo® Ninebark Zone 3-7 H 8-10' x W 6-8'*  
Known for its reddish-purple foliage on long arching canes, it blooms in spring with creamy-white flowers that contrast against the dark foliage. Hardy and durable.

## Populus | Poplar

*Populus deltoides* 'Siouxland' | *Siouxland Poplar* Zone 3-9 H 70-90' x W 40'  
Cottonless, fast-growing, rounded crown. Tolerates moist sites. Yellow fall color.

*Populus nigra* 'Theves' | *Theves Poplar* Zone 2-9 H 50-60' x W 8-10'  
Fast growing, spire-like, for hedges and screens. A longer lived replacement for Lombardy poplar. Disease-free with yellow fall color.

*Populus tremula* 'Erecta' | *Swedish Columnar Aspen* Zone 2-9 H 30' x W 10-15'  
Small narrow columnar tree with dark green leaves with gray underneath. Golden-red fall color. Foliage trembles in the slightest breeze. Dense vertical branching makes an interesting accent plant. Prefers acidic soils.

*Populus tremuloides* | *Quaking Aspen* Zone 2-7 H 60-80' x W 30'  
A native tree with greenish to white bark, beautiful yellow fall color. Hardy and adaptable to many soil types; excellent for naturalizing.

*Populus angustifolia* | *Narrowleaf Cottonwood* Zone 2 H 75' x W 40'  
A vertical growing native with willow like foliage. Fall foliage is a brilliant yellow. Good for moist locations. Excellent in higher altitudes.

*Populus sargentii* | *Straight Plains Cottonwood* Zone 3 H 100' x W 50'  
Fast growing, cottonless tree. The original found on the plains. Tolerates moist soil. altitudes.

*Populus x. 'Highland'* | *Highland Cottonwood* Zone 3 H 100' x W 50'  
Introduced from Highland Nursery in Greeley, CO. Fast-growing, seedless. Smaller variety good for smaller landscapes.

## Prunus | Cherry, Plum

*Prunus cerasifera* 'Newport' | *Newport Purple Leaf Plum* Zone 4-8 H 15-20' x W 15-20'  
Small, hardy tree with upright growth and rounded crown. Reddish-purple foliage, pink flowers, 1" purple fruit. Attractive accent plant.

*Prunus maackii* | *Amur Chokecherry* Zone 2-6 H 20-30' x W 25-30'  
Small tree bearing white flowers and small black fruits (usually eaten by birds). Beautiful, shiny, cinnamon-golden brown to dark red exfoliating bark. A simply beautiful plant for the winter landscape.

*Prunus virginiana* 'Canada Red' | *Canada Red Chokecherry* Zone 2-6 H 20-25' x W 15-20'  
Small, hardy ornamental with greenish new leaves that mature maroon. White flowers in late April, edible fruit ripens to purple. Requires strict drainage and light soil.

*Prunus nigra 'Princess Kay' | Princess Kay Plum Zone 2-6 H 15' x W 8-10'*

Small, ornamental plum featuring double white blooms early in spring, offsetting the dark black bark and prominent lenticels. Fruits are few, if any. The perfect tree for small gardens and landscapes.

### **Pyrus | Pear**

*Pyrus calleryana 'Autumn Blaze' | Autumn Blaze Pear Zone 4 H 35' x W 20'*

Distinct shape with a horizontal, irregular, and open growth habit. Glossy green summer foliage with spectacular fall color Blooms early into spring. More hardy than other varieties of Callery Pear.

*Pyrus ussuriensis 'Bailfrost' | Mountain Frost Pear Zone 3 H 20-30' x W 20'*

An improved selection with a more vigorous, upright growth habit. Attractive flowers cover the tree in spring backed by dark green, leathery foliage. Some 3/8" fruit may be produced some years.

*Quercus macrocarpa | Bur Oak Zone 3-8 H 60-80' x W 60-80'*

Hardy native with large, rounded crown. Recognized by its strong irregular, horizontal branching and corky bark. Tolerates a wide variety of soils. Yellow/brown to purplish fall color. A good choice where other trees will not grow.

*Quercus palustris | Pin Oak Zone 4-8 H 40-60' x W 40'*

Fast-growing oak with broad, pyramidal crown. Hardy native with bright red fall color. This tree is intolerant of high pH of alkaline soils and should be corrected before planting.

*Quercus rubra | Northern Red Oak Zone 4-8 H 60-80' x W 50'*

Large native shade tree with rounded crown. One of the fastest-growing oaks with dense, lustrous foliage, red fall color. Large acorns make this tree attractive to wildlife.

### **Salix | Willow**

*Salix alba 'Tristis' | Niobe Weeping Willow Zone 4-8 H 50' x W 50'*

Golden barked willow with wide spreading head and long, golden, drooping branches. Easy to grow, tolerates heavy, wetsoils

*Salix caprea 'Pendula' | Weeping Pussy Willow Zone 4-8 H 5-6' x W 5-6'*

A strong, weeping form of pussy willow grafted onto a standard. Very pretty small tree for landscape accents.

*Salix integra 'Hakuro Nishiki' - Tree Form | Dappled Willow Grafted Zone 4-7 H 5-6' x W 4-6'*

This elegant little tree features tri-colored leaves of green, pink and cream.

*Salix 'Prairie Cascade' | Prairie Cascade Weeping Willow Zone 3-6 H 40' x W 40'*

A beautiful, hardy weeping willow for large areas with plenty of moisture. Dark, glossy green foliage.

*Salix purpurea 'Pendula' | Dwarf Weeping Arctic Blue Leaf Willow Zone 4 H 12-15' x W 10-12'*

Excellent small specimen for patios or water features. Resembles miniature weeping willow.

## **Sorbus | Mountain Ash**

*Sorbus aucuparia* | *European Mountain Ash* Zone 3 H 45' x W 25'  
Clusters of blooms in spring followed by clusters of orange-red berries.

*Sorbus decora* | *Showy Mountain Ash* Zone 2-6 H 20-25' x W 20'  
Fireblight resistant. Small ornamental tree with rounded crown. White flowers, orange-red fruit. Just try to keep robins and cedar waxwings away Hardy, slow growing, and disease resistant. Orange-red fall foliage.

*Sorbus x hybrida* | *Oak Leaf Mountain Ash* Zone 4 H 30' x W 20'  
Very uniform with orange-red fruit. Leaves are lobed like an oak.

## **Syringa | Lilac**

*Syringa laciniata* - *Tree Form* | *Cutleaf Lilac* Zone 4 H 6-8' x W 6-8'  
Cutleaf lilac distinguishes itself with lacy, small, lobed foliage that is truly elegant. It is resistant to mildew and quite tolerant of heat. Spring blooming with fragrant 3" pale lavender flower panicles grafted on a 3' standard.

*Syringa meyeri* 'Palibin' - *Tree Form* | *Dwarf Korean Lilac* Zone 4-7 H 6' x W 5-6'  
The dwarf Korean lilac grafted onto a standard makes a lovely small accent for the landscape. Fragrant.

*Syringa patula* 'Miss Kim' - *Tree Form* | *Miss Kim Lilac* Zone 3 H 6-8' x W 6-8'  
The same handsome, dependable shrub grafted onto a standard. This lilac blooms two weeks or so later than vulgarishybrids and develops bronzy fall foliage. Tolerates hot, dry locations.

*Syringa reticulata* | *Japanese Tree Lilac* Zone 3 H 25' x W 25'  
Large panicles of creamy white flowers in June-July. Beautiful plant can be used as large shrub or small tree.

*Syringa reticulata* 'Ivory Silk' | *Ivory Silk® Japanese Tree Lilac* Zone 3-8 H 25' x W 15'  
Very similar to species, but selected for narrow, upright crown. Can be used in smaller spaces.

## **Tilia | Linden**

*Tilia americana* | *American Linden* Zone 3-8 H 80' x W 50'  
Large, green leaves and dense spreading head. Fragrant flowers in early summer. Rapid grower and very adaptable to a variety of soil conditions.

*Tilia americana* 'Boulevard' | *Boulevard Linden* Zone 3-8 H 60' x W 30'  
A narrow, pyramidal form of American linden with ascending branches. Good street tree or for sites where a narrow crown is required. Fragrant yellow spring flowers. Yellow fall foliage.

*Tilia americana 'Redmond' | Redmond Linden Zone 4-8 H 40-60' x W 25-30'*

Uniform, pyramidal selection of American linden. Branches show reddish color in winter. Bright yellow fall color; Largestleaved linden.

*Tilia cordata 'Greenspire' | Greenspire® Linden Zone 4-7 H 40-50' x W 30-35'*

Suitable for boulevard planting. Strong, straight trunk. Fragrant yellow flowers, yellow fall color.

## **Ulmus | Elm**

*Ulmus carpinifolia x parvifolia | Frontier Elm Zone 4 H 40' x W 30'*

This hybrid elm exhibits a high level of disease resistance to the fungus that causes Dutch elm disease. Glossy green foliage turns to a burgundy in the fall. This selection has a pyramidal shape like the American elm.

*Ulmus davidiana var. japonica 'Discovery' | Discovery Japanese Elm Zone 3-7 H 70' x W 50-60'*

Tough and hardy selection with green foliage changing to yellow in fall. Highly resistant to Dutch elm disease.

*Ulmus 'Morton' | Accolade® Elm Zone 4-7 H 70' x W 50-60'*

New elm hybrid that shows resistance to Dutch elm disease. Large, broadly vase-shaped shade tree for larger sites.

## **Viburnum**

*Viburnum lentago - Tree Form | Nannyberry Zone 2-8 H 20' x W 15'*

Nannyberry is a tough native that tolerates wet, dry, sun, shade and is a handsome small landscape tree. In June, very large creamy white flower clusters explode against the glossy green foliage. In autumn the pendulous blue-black fruits glisten against reddish-purple leaves. Excellent winter food source for birds.

*Viburnum opulus 'Compact European' | Compact European Viburnum Zone 3-8 H 5' x W 5'*

A perfect choice for poor sites. This plant tolerates wet, poor, dry soils, is tolerant of heat, pollution, and low or high pH. Upright oval growth habit, cream-white flowers in early June turn to bright red fruit. In spring, birds consume the old fruit readily.

*Viburnum opulus 'Roseum' - Tree Form | Snowball Viburnum Zone 3-8 H 8-12' x W 8-12'*

This popular shrub is presented here as an attractive and functional small patio tree, grafted onto a standard, with limitless uses: borders, foundations, and small lawn specimen. It bears handsome green foliage and a profusion of double white flower clusters over a long period in mid to late spring.
